**DERMAdoctor SPECIALIST SKIN CARE PUTS ACNE IN ‘TIME OUT’ WITH
RELEASE OF *AIN’T MISBEHAVIN’*™ MEDICATED ACNE THERAPIES**

**Enhanced AHA/BHA Cleanser and Fortified Salicylic Acid Treatment Serum Work to Clear Skin,

Consisting of a medicated cleanser and an all-over treatment serum for daily use, *Ain’t Misbehavin’* Medicated Therapies contain all necessary ingredients to disrupt acne’s proliferation cycle, allowing the skin to heal and resist future breakouts.

“Acne is a developmental disorder of the cells lining the skin’s sebaceous (oil) glands,” explains Dr. Audrey Kunin, a board-certified dermatologist and founder of DERMAdoctor. “Instead of easily exfoliating themselves onto the skin’s surface, the cells become sticky, bind together and plug the glands. As an oil gland continues to produce sebum below the plug, *Propionobacterium acnes* (P. acnes) multiply and contribute to glandular inflammation. This constant cycle of persistent plugging, excessive oil build-up and bacteria-related inflammation eventually cause the gland to rupture and the tell-tale acne papule or cyst to appear.”

Although Dr. Kunin describes the individualized treatment of acne as more of an art than a science, five key measures essential to the management of the disorder include killing bacteria, eliminating unnecessary skin oils, addressing underlying hormonal triggers, unplugging pores and reducing inflammation.

“Because of stringent FDA guidelines, we have historically been limited in the way we can treat acne over-the-counter (OTC),” explains Kunin. “Standard OTC treatments will either eliminate bacteria or help soften debris trapped within the pores—which simply isn’t enough on its own. Thanks to newly created technologies and the discovery of active natural ingredients that promise medicinal benefits, ‘normal’ acne therapy can be enhanced. *Ain’t Misbehavin’* allows the consumer to use an enriched formulation targeting not just one, but all five points in the pathway of blemish development.”

Ain’t Misbehavin’ Medicated AHA/BHA Cleanser for Oily, Blemish-Prone or Combination Skin addresses these factors in a single creamy, low-foaming, soap-free, pH balanced base. Pores are unplugged and cellular debris is dissolved by two percent Salicylic Acid, the highest level of Beta Hydroxy Acid (BHA) FDA approved to treat acne. The addition of 15 percent buffered Glycolic Acid helps ensure the most thorough chemical exfoliation available in an OTC formula. Witch Hazel, a time-honored astringent with potential antibacterial properties, works synergistically with Sebum Sequestering Micro-particles™, a patented polymer technology that effectively traps excess surface skin oils. Allantoin rounds out the mix with its powerful anti-irritant affect on the skin.

A first in OTC acne therapy, *Ain’t Misbehavin’ Acne Control Serum* further disciplines problem skin by fortifying a two percent Salicylic Acid foundation with Tea Tree Oil, a nonirritating plant extract with disinfecting properties that are shown to be particularly effective against P. acnes. Sebum Sequestering Micro-particles soak up excess skin oils while Nordihydroguaiaretic Acid (NDGA) reduces sebum production by first diminishing the level of the masculine hormone DHT in the skin. Lastly, Oleanolic Acid, White Tea and other natural botanicals neutralize skin inflammation and redness while protecting against environmental damage.
